First Sunday of On-Site Services – June 21, 2020

1. Please note new service times. **9:00-10:00am – Face masks required**
10:30-11:30am – Face masks recommended but are optional
2. Live streaming will continue at both services. Those who are at-risk, have symptoms of illness, or are uncomfortable worshipping on-site are encouraged and blessed to watch remotely. 4. Please arrive no earlier than 10-15 minutes before the service.

Information for Parents

1. Our Infant Nursery will currently be unstaffed but open for parents to utilize during the service. The Toddler Nursery will be closed.
2. For now, there is no Sunday School or Children's Church. We are discussing how and when we can expand our ministry to children. Stay tuned.
3. We aim to have kid-friendly services with a special children's story in the 10:30 service. Parents are encouraged to bring some appropriate activities for their children as necessary.

Physical Distancing

1. Ushers will assist with seating in every other row allowing 3 seats between household groups.
2. Ushers will dismiss you row by row at the end of the service.
3. You are encouraged to visit outdoors before and after the service.
4. We request no hugs or handshakes for now.
5. Be mindful of those who prefer to keep a distance for now.

Touch Free

1. Wherever possible, doors will be opened for you.
2. Bulletins will not be handed out by greeters, but they will be emailed or mailed.
3. Instead of passing offering containers, an offering box will be at the back of the sanctuary.

Face Masks

1. For the 1st service at 9:00am, masks are required.
2. For the 2nd service at 10:30am, masks are recommended but are optional.
3. Disposable masks are available should you need one. Contact an usher.

For your Protection

1. Wall-mounted hand sanitizers are available in the lobbies and the rear of the sanctuary.
2. High-touch surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized before each service.
3. Café is closed.
4. Water fountains are closed, so bring a water bottle if needed.
5. Playground is closed.
